

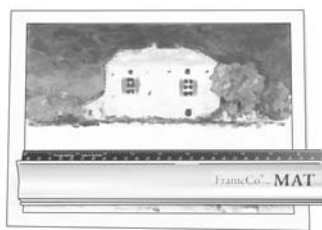

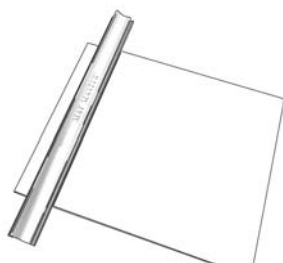
#101 BEVEL CUTTER

#14200

PERFECT BEVEL CUTS EVERYTIME



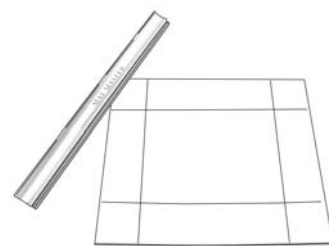
1 Measure the actual picture area you wish to frame by using the Mat Master™ Rule.



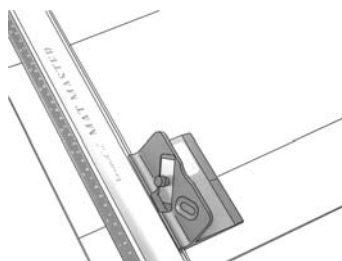
2 Add on the border dimension eg. 7cm (3") all around, plus the image size, equals the size of the blank mat board.



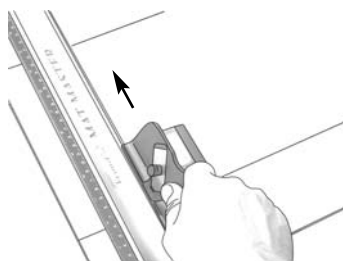
3 On the back of the mat measure and mark the 7cm (3") position, top and bottom, and draw a line between the 2 marks. Extend line to edges of board.



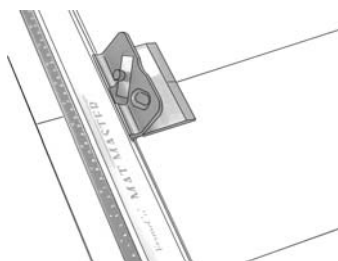
4 Continue around the 3 sides remaining so your mat looks like the above diagram.



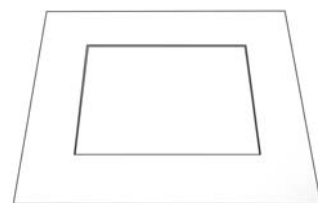
5 Position the rule on the left hand side of the mount aligned with the pencil mark. Place the cutter onto the Rule so that the start/stop line is approx. 1 mm (1/16") before the pencil mark.



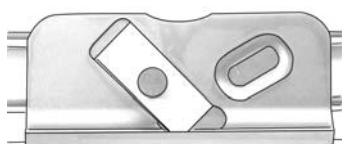
6 Press the cutter head into the mount and slide up the rule until the start/stop line has passed the top pencil line by approx. 1 mm (1/16").



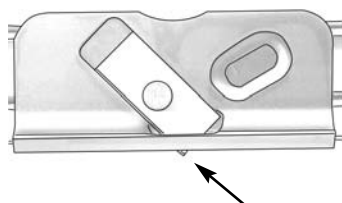
7 Rotate 90° and repeat the last 2 steps on the remaining 3 sides.



8 Flip over the mount to reveal a crisp, clean 45° bevel cut mount. If you wish to convert this to a double mount follow steps from 9 through 14.



Blade up for safety. There are two threaded screw holes. Top for when not in use and the bottom for cutting.



Blade down when cutting. Use the screw to adjust the blade depth.

Adjustment of Blade Depth

For storage we recommend you position the blade using the top screw hole so that the blade is not protruding. Adjust the blade using then bottom screw hole for cutting accurate bevel mats. The blade should only just protrude through the mat board for clean, easy cutting.
